International Student Agreement Form

If admitted to Century College, I agree to:

- Maintain my F-1 status with respect to all United States federal regulations and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities policies for the duration of my studies at Century College. I understand that the rules F-1 students must follow include, but are not limited to:
 - a. **Be enrolled each Fall and Spring semester as a full-time student** for 12 or more credits. I will attend and participate in all classes.
 - b. **Not be employed outside of Century College campus** without proper authorization from Century College and/or US Citizenship and Immigration Services.
 - c. Maintain a valid passport and Form I-20 at all times.
 - d. Purchase the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities' approved health insurance plan.*

Minnesota State Policy 3.4; <u>Procedure 3.4.1 Undergraduate Admissions Part 5, Subpart B, 2</u>: "International students must purchase the system-approved student health insurance, except those students whose sponsoring agency or government certifies that the student is covered under a plan provided by the sponsoring agency or government."

*International Students must maintain the approved health insurance coverage throughout the duration of their enrollment at Century College. Century College reserves the right to suspend students who do not comply with this mandatory insurance requirement. Century College assumes no responsibility for medical expenses.

- 2. Have adequate funds available to pay all educational and living expenses for the duration of my studies at Century College. I understand that I will not receive financial aid from the College (such as grants, loans, employment) and the College accepts no responsibility for my financial needs.
- 3. **Arrive at least two weeks prior to the start of classes** in order to complete International Student Welcome Day, course registration, and other orientation-related activities.
- 4. **Abide by Century College policies and procedures** as they apply to student conduct and academic progress.
- 5. Complete the Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) at Century College's Student Health Clinic during the first semester to determine exposure to tuberculosis. Complete any required tuberculin follow-up exam and treatment. Provide proof of immunizations for measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) and for tetanus and diphtheria (Td). I understand my registration for the second semester will be on hold until I complete these items.
