Apply for an F-1 Visa Outside of the United States

Step 1 Apply to Century College

Step 2 Receive Acceptance Letter and Form I-20

- Documents will be emailed to the address you provide in your online application.
- After receiving your acceptance letter, visit the Next Steps for Admitted Students webpage for a complete list of steps you must take before your first semester at Century College: www.century.edu/admissions/international-student/next-steps-admitted-students.

Step 3 Pay I-901 SEVIS Fee

 Students must register their SEVIS ID number by paying a government registration fee online at www.fmjfee.com.

Step 4 Submit visa application and schedule visa interview at US Embassy

- Contact your local US Embassy for visa application and appointment information or visit their website.
- Bring Form I-20, all financial documents, and other required documents to the visa interview. For more

Step 5 Receive F-1 Visa and Prepare for Arrival in the US

- Receive F-1 visa in passport.
- Follow all Century College instructions to prepare for arrival. Check your email on a regular basis so you do not miss any important information! Students are required to arrive at Century at least two weeks before classes begin.

F-1 visa students may enter the United States no more than 30 days before the program start date found on their Form I-20. Arriving before that date will result in being denied entrance.
