Students currently in the United States in F-1 status, who want to transfer their SEVIS Record to Century College should follow this process:

## Step 1 Apply to Century College

- Visit our website for details and deadlines. (Follow the link above.)

## Step 2 Receive Acceptance Letter

- Document will be emailed to the address you provide in your online application.
- After receiving your acceptance letter, visit the Next Steps for Admitted Students webpage for a complete list of steps you must take before your first semester at Century College: [www.century.edu/admissions/international-student/next-steps-admitted-students](http://www.century.edu/admissions/international-student/next-steps-admitted-students).

## Step 3 Request SEVIS Record Transfer

- Submit your Century College acceptance letter to the international advisor (DSO) at your current school and request that they transfer your SEVIS Record to Century, SEVIS school code: SPM214F00424000.

## Step 4 Report to Century College and Prepare for Semester Start

- Report to Century College by completing a New Student Check-In Appointment at least two weeks before classes begin.
- Receive Form I-20.
- Follow all Century College instructions to prepare for semester start.
