Century College Counselors are available to help you through in-person appointments, remotely through phone or video conferencing via ZOOM appointments and email. Please follow this process to connect most effectively with Counseling Services:

- 1. If it is NOT a crisis**, please make an appointment in [Starfish](#) with your assigned pathway counselor (see page 3 for a step-by-step guide on how you can schedule an appointment). If you have any questions or are not able to make an appointment in Starfish, please contact the front desk of the Advising, Counseling, and Career (ACC) Center at acc@century.edu or 651.779.3285.
- 2. If it IS a crisis**, please contact the front desk of the Advising, Counseling, and Career (ACC) Center at acc@century.edu or 651.779.3285. We will reach out to the you as soon as possible during our business hours (Mondays and Tuesdays 8am - 6pm, Wednesdays and Thursdays 8am - 4:30pm and Fridays 8am - 12pm - not including holidays). Please include your name, student ID, and your preferred contact information plus a brief summary of your crisis situation. **If it is outside of business hours, additional resources are listed below. If there is a threat to your immediate safety or the safety of others, call 911.**

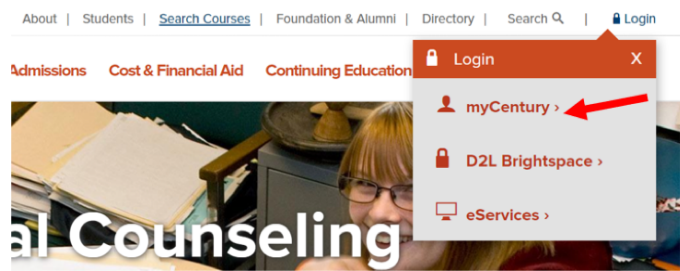

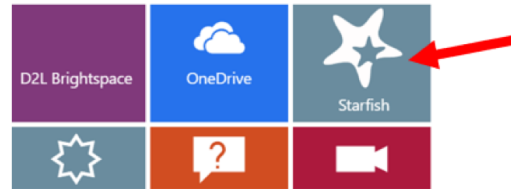

Finding Your Assigned Pathway Counselor

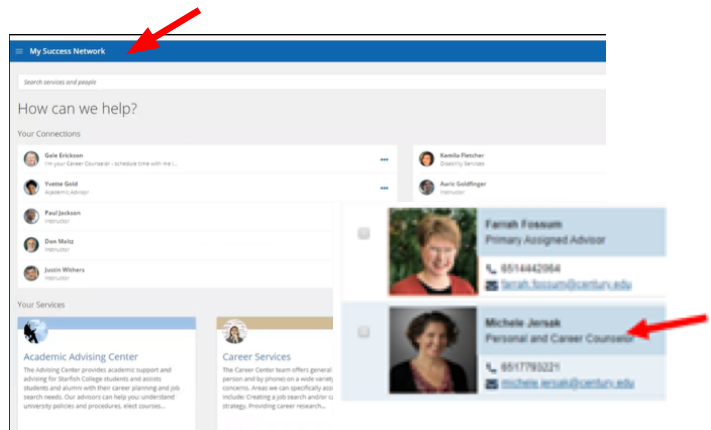
1. Your assigned pathway counselor can be found in the “My Success Network” on Starfish. To access Starfish, go into myCentury.
