When traveling outside of the United States carry these documents with you to be prepared for re-entry to the US:

- Valid Form I-20 (with travel signature dated in the last year)
- Valid passport (valid for 6 months into the future on date of re-entry)
- Valid F-1 visa
- Printed proof of enrollment past and future (recommended), examples: transcript, course schedule
- Printed financial information showing proof of necessary funds to cover tuition and living expenses
- If you have optional practical training approval, also carry your Employment Authorization Document (EAD card) and proof of employment (letter from employer)
- If you changed immigration status while in the US, carry change of status approval notice (I-797)
